The Trust shall be managed by a Board of Trustees.






### 19. SECRETARY OF THE TRUST:

### 24. APPLICATION OF PROPERTY AND INCOME:

It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income shall be applied for any purpose which is not public charitable purpose and nothing herein shall be constructed to authorise the Trustees to utilize the Trust assets or its income for any non-charitable purpose.

### 25. TREASURER OF THE TRUST:

The Trustees shall elect from amongst themselves a Treasurer and determine the period for which he is to hold office. The first Treasurer of Trust shall be Smt. Shalini Singh, Trustee who shall hold the office of Treasurer for life.

## 26. POWER TO EMPLOY EMPLOYEES, AGENTS AND COMMITTEES:

The Trustees shall be entitled from time to time appoint with or without remuneration and on such terms and conditions as they may think proper, persons or agents and to appoint Committees as they may think necessary to function under the authority and control of the Trustees for carrying out the objects of the Trust of THESE PRESENTS or the management thereof and may within the limits of their own powers invest them with all such powers

### 28. POWER TO AMEND RULES:






